The Edmond J. Safra Philanthropic Foundation strengthened its long standing relationship with the Shoah Memorial and its dedication to education at 2:15 p.m. on April 25, when the Foundation's Chairwoman, Mrs. Lily Safra, and the Memorial's President, Eric de Rothschild, signed an agreement establishing the Edmond J. Safra Education Institute.

"The Edmond J. Safra Education Institute will ensure that tens of thousands of people each year – especially schoolchildren – will be better prepared to stand up against hate and intolerance in our society," said Mrs. Lily Safra. "I know how proud my husband would have been to have his name associated with such important work."

Established in perpetuity, the Institute will provide for the growth and development of the Shoah Memorial's education initiative. With new facilities and programs, the Memorial hopes to expand outreach and education initiatives and cater to the specific needs of schoolchildren ages 8 to 12 in understanding the impact and importance of the Shoah in history.
